Let's talk Gender Pronouns



(most common - she / her / hers = he / him / his = they / them / theirs = zie / zim / zir)

- **a.** The gender pronoun I use tells others how I would like to be addressed.
- **b.** Gender neutral pronouns such as THEY or ZIE don't associate with a specific gender.
- c. Respect my pronoun and you will be inclusive.
 Don't respect my pronoun and I may feel excluded.
- d. If you don't know, don't be afraid to ask me "What's your preferred pronoun?"
