Constitutional rules and procedures for nomination process

- Nominations will be conducted in the form of petitions. The process is explained below. There
 is an important distinction between the process for the nine sectoral vice-presidents and these
 four positions: President, Secretary-Treasurer, Executive Vice-President and Recorder.
- To register nominations for President, Secretary-Treasurer, Executive Vice-President or Recorder, an active Local 1000A member must submit a petition signed by 1.8 per cent of the membership of Local 1000A based on the average monthly active membership of the local union for the 12-month period of June 2011 – May 2012. See previous page for number of signatures required for each position.
- To register nominations for a sectoral Vice-President, an active Local 1000A member must
- submit a petition signed by 1.8 per cent of the membership of that sector based on the average monthly active membership of the local union, in that sector, for the 12 month period of June 2011 May 2012. See previous page for number of signatures required for each position.
- In accordance with the International Constitution Article 35, a candidate for President, Secretary-Treasurer, Executive Vice-President or Recorder, must be an active member for a continuous aggregate of at least 12 months immediately preceding the month in which nominations are held.
- In accordance with the International Constitution Article 35, any active member of the local
 union shall be eligible to vote for President, Secretary-Treasurer, Executive Vice-President or
 Recorder, as outlined in the International Constitution.
