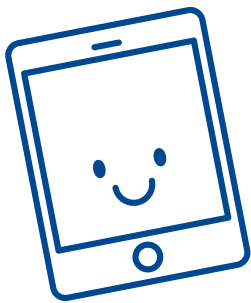

Remembering Africville



Dating back to the 1830s, the Halifax neighbourhood of Africville became the home to many Black Canadians, former American slaves and Black settlers. In the 1960s, the city evicted the residents and expropriated Africville in the name of “urban renewal”. In 2010, a settlement was reached which included a formal apology for the loss of culture, heritage and tradition of Africville.
