

KEY STEPS IN A WORK REFUSAL

Worker refuses to work because they have **reason to believe** the work endangers health or safety. Worker reports circumstances to employer/supervisor. Worker representative is called in. Employer/supervisor investigates in presence of the worker and worker representative. Does employer/supervisor agree health or safety is endangered? NO YES If reasonable grounds exist, Worker agrees and Corrective action is taken. worker can continue to refuse work. returns to work. Ministry of Labour inspector is notified. Worker returns to work. Worker remains in a safe place. Worker may be assigned reasonable alternative work. Inspector investigates the refusal and consults with worker, employer/supervisor No other worker shall and worker representative. be assigned the work in question unless advised of the current Written decision is sent to employer/supervisor, refusal in the presence worker and worker representative. of a worker representative. They also have Corrective action is taken if ordered. the right to refuse. Worker returns to work. Employer or worker can appeal inspector's decision within 30 days.
