Wages

Attendance for the conference is on a volunteer basis. The local will make a request of your employer for consideration for your time off to attend, however, arrangements **will not** be made to have you paid. **You will have to formally arrange for your time off.**

Accommodations

Accommodations will be provided to all stewards, for the evening of Saturday, September 21, if requested on the registration form. As per local union policy, accommodations for the evening of Friday September 20 can be made, should participants have to travel 120 km or more (one way). The local union uses Google maps, or a similar program, for accommodation eligibility verification.

Local union policy states "double occupancy (shared) accommodations" for these conferences, however, in the interest of the health and well being of participants due to the ongoing presence of COVID-19 and variants, for 2025 we will be booking single accommodations for participants who request accommodations on the registration form. Accommodations for family members will not be arranged.

Safety

Harassment of any form will not be tolerated during any union function. It is expected that all participants be dedicated to preventing harassment and discrimination while at union functions.
